The Demong Family Memorial Bursary is a \$600.00 Bursary available to Comox Valley students with proof of registration in post secondary studies at a University, College, Technical School or similar institution for the school year beginning September 2022.

DESCRIPTION: The Demong Family Memorial Bursary, worth \$600.00 is managed by the Comox Valley Farmers Institute. It was formed as a memorial to Roger Demong, his wife Marion, and their three young children who all died in a tragic car accident in 1980. Roger was the Comox Valley District agriculturist for many years and was passionate about composting and promoting the recycling of our organic waste stream back onto farmland.

The Selection for this bursary will be made by the Directors of the Comox Valley Farmers Institute Bursary Committee. Applicants are to meet the applicant guidelines and criteria as detailed below and fill in the attached questionnaire; the complete package should be in the hands of the Bursary Committee no later than **August 1, 2022 either by mail or email.**

Applicant Guidelines and Criteria:

1. The applicant must:
 - a. reside, or his/her family must reside within the Comox Valley.
 - b. Be a graduating high school student registered/enrolled in post secondary studies at a University, College, Technical School or similar institution for the September 2022 school year.
2. Preference will be given to a student who is intending on or pursuing further agricultural studies/education and who is likely to make a contribution to agriculture/farming.
3. While acceptable academic performance is required, the award will not necessarily be made on the basis of academic standing. The successful candidate will be of good character and practical ability.
4. Funds will be awarded only after proof of registration/enrollment for September 2022 at a University, College, Technical School or similar institution has been confirmed.
5. Applicants must provide a transcript detailing courses taken and marks achieved from last institution attended.
6. Applicants must fill in the attached questionnaire to the best of their ability.

*The public media may be informed of the award recipient and the recipient may be requested to submit a photograph and some information to be published either in printed media and/or on facebook.
